

**Proposal for the Provision of One-off Grant for Supporting the Implementation of the Senior
Secondary Subject Citizenship and Social Development
2023-24**

1. Developing or procuring relevant learning and teaching resources	\$3,000
2. Subsidising students and teachers to participate in the Mainland interflow activities or study tours relating to the CSD curriculum <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● EDB's compulsory Mainland Study Tour for all S5 (around 122 students + 15 teachers) – 28 data cards (\$48 x 28 = \$1,344) ● Subsidizing around 80 S4-5 students and 8 teachers to visit the Mainland organized by the Civic Education Committee (\$1,000 x 88 = \$88,000) ● Visa for the ethnic minorities (\$1,000 x 3 = \$3,000) 	\$92,344
3. Organising school-based learning activities for enhancing the learning and teaching effectiveness of CSD <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Gifts for the Constitution Day Quiz (\$60 x 15 classes) ● Gifts for the Basic Law Quiz (\$60 x 15 classes) ● Gifts for the National Security Education Day Quiz (\$60 x 10 classes) 	\$2,400
4. Organising or subsidising students to participate in joint-school / cross-curricular activities relating to the CSD curriculum held in Hong Kong or in the Mainland <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Activities organized by the Civic Education Committee that involve roughly 40 students (\$500 x 40) 	\$20,000
