THE SCORING SYSTEM

- Part A (Questions 1 to 6) 3 points for correct response, 0 points for incorrect or no response.
- Part B (Questions 7 to 15) 2 points for correct response, 0 points for incorrect or no response.

AWARD ALLOCATION

In each year group, certificates of merit have been awarded to approximately the top 50% of students sitting the competition. As a general rule, the top 2% of students receive High Distinction certificates, the next 13% receive Distinction certificates and the next 35% receive Credit certificates. The remaining students receive a certificate of Participation. These percentages may vary slightly according to the number of students in a group and the score distribution.
