Explanatory Notes

- 1. The proposed SDP5 is built on a solid foundation of the previous four SDPs, namely "Reading to Learn" in 2002-2007, "Promoting Quality Learning" in 2007-2012, "Space for Transformation" in 2012-2017 and "Revisiting Our Past, Connecting the Future" in 2017-2021.
